In 2008 The Zen Center earned an 'Energy Oscar for Environmental Commitment' presented by California Interfaith Power & Light.

The Project Challenge

As a result of their dedication to the environment the Zen Center contacted Sun Light & Power to install a photovoltaic system in order to reduce their carbon footprint. Because the Zen Center occupies an historic building designed by Julia Morgan in 1922 it was imperative to preserve the integrity of the building's aesthetic.

Additionally, all fire code access requirements were honored. The result is a seamless integration of modern technology into a landmark building design.
